



***What if my child has a fever?***

Please keep the child home until fever free for 72 hours unless a doctor's note verifies another condition.

***What is the definition of a fever?***

A temperature above 100.4 is considered a fever.

***What if my child was in close contact with a COVID-19 positive case?***

Please keep your child home for 14 days beginning with the last known close contact.

***What is considered a close contact?***

Being within 6 ft. of a positive individual for a cumulative time of 15 minutes starting from two days before the onset of symptoms or a test that has a positive result is considered a close contact.

***What if someone in my household has COVID-19?***

Your child is considered a close contact. Close contacts stay home from school for 14 days since the last close contact with the COVID-19 individual.

***What if my child has COVID-19?***

Please stay home for 10 days after the test result. The child may return provided they are fever free and decreasing symptoms after the 10 day period.

***What if I do not get my child tested for COVID-19, but it is suspected?***

Please stay home for 14 days after onset of symptoms. The child may return provided they are fever free and decreasing symptoms after the 14 day period. Siblings will also stay home during that period as well and possibly longer if COVID-19 is suspected.

***What if someone in my child's classroom has COVID-19?***

Students will be contact traced marking a 48 period starting with the testing date or onset of symptoms. Close contacts will be quarantined at home for 14 days from the onset of symptoms.

***What if I have my child tested and they receive a negative test result?***

Provided that the child is not a close contact, they may return to school 24 hours after the test result if they are fever free and are not experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.





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
